Our BIG question this term is: What do you see?

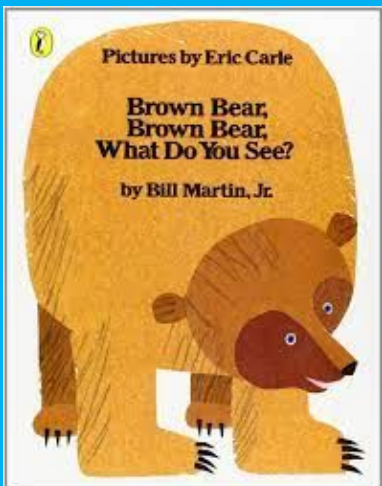

Some of the activities we will be doing this term include:

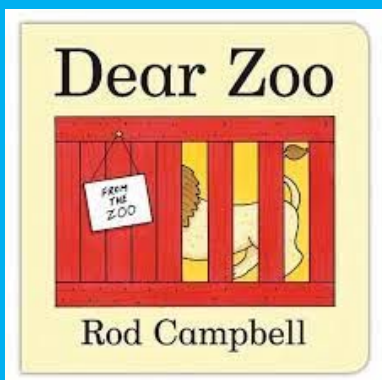
Researching animals and their habitats

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

A key aspect of our role is to provide experiences and support that will enable children to develop a positive sense of themselves and of others.

We welcome all feelings and support ways children can manage their thoughts and feelings with the use of visual aids such as props, puppet and persona dolls and through role play . **This term we continue to explore our emotions, exploring ways of regulating and naming some of our bigger emotions.**

Communication and Language

Children will have the opportunity to explore a range of books supported by visuals, props and songs over a 2 week cycle. Promoting the use of repetition and key phrases. These support and encourage communication and language development and confidence for storytelling. **This term we will be using words to describe building on our vocabulary and joining in with the Makaton signs of the 'Brown Bear' story.**

Physical Development

Physical development is vital for all-round development and both gross and fine motor skills. Outdoor learning is encouraged in all weather so please make sure your child comes suitably clothed and warmly dressed with gloves and hats so they can explore comfortably. **This term we will be practising our balancing skills and exploring our senses.**

Literacy

Through rhymes, singing songs, games and techniques children are supported to develop their speaking and listening skills.

Children will be encouraged to practise developing their gross and fine motor skills which are key elements for mark making.

This term we will be using props to sequence and retell stories, sharing our new library loans around Eid and learning part of the songs 'Down in the jungle' and 'I can sing a rainbow'.

Mathematics

Within Daycare we support the development of maths through fun and physical activities such as songs, actions and group games. We focus on the foundations of numbers 1,2,3; representing, subitising, recognising numerals and counting.

This term we will be exploring 1:1 correspondence, patterns and shapes.

Understanding of the World

Within Understanding of the World we celebrate the children of our community while also making sense of the world around us. We celebrate what makes children unique and respect individual wishes and beliefs. As a setting this is reflected in our celebrations, within the environment and books. **This term we will be discussing and celebrating cultures and traditions from around the world. We will also be celebrating the King's Coronation.**

Expressive Arts and Design

Throughout our topic we will be supporting children to use their imagination in play and to get creative.

We will use props to support understanding storytelling and singing.

This term we will be making Eid creations, exploring colour and how they can be changed. We will also be moving in different ways while listening to music from around the world.
