Attendance

At Comper we monitor the attendance of our children on a weekly and termly basis. We look at attendance across each class and at individuals.

Government stipulate that children's attendance should not fall below 96% on a regular basis. Unsurprisingly, poor attendance at nursery and school has a direct impact on children underachieving in the longer term.

Attendance at Comper is currently well below 96%. We are very aware that there have been some very nasty bugs around and that lots of our children have been very unwell and of course they should not be in school if they are ill. However, please do try to ensure that your children are in school regularly when they are well as they miss out on so much if they are not in and we miss seeing them! This is particularly important, after having such a disrupted start to their early education over the last 18 months.
