
Building new relationships supporting transitions and change

This term we will be celebrating: World Ocean Day, Healthy Eating Week, Father's Day and Eid!

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

A key aspect of our role is to provide experiences and support that will enable children to develop a positive sense of themselves and of others.

We welcome all feelings and support ways children can manage their thoughts and feelings with the use of visual aids such as props, puppet and persona dolls and through role play. This term we will be talking to some of the children about moving to Nursery and how they may feel. The children will have a 'Buddy' in Nursery who will help and encourage the children to explore their new environment. We will also be welcoming new families, supporting them to settle and feel safe in their new environment.

Communication and Language

Children will have the opportunity to explore a range of books supported by visuals, props and songs over a 2 week cycle. Promoting the use of repetition and key phrases. These support and encourage communication and language development and confidence for storytelling. This term we will be introducing focused text to encourage and prompt questions and discussion about the world around us. And recapping on our Daycare experiences building sentences with support: when I'm at Daycare I feel/enjoy......

Physical Development

Physical development is vital for all-round development and both gross and fine motor skills. Outdoor learning is encouraged in all weather so please make sure your child comes suitably clothed and warmly dressed with gloves and hats so they can explore comfortably. This term we will be building on our fine and gross motor skills. We will also be engaging in challenge, supporting progression and a 'can do' 'attitude'. We will also be experimenting with different way to eat healthy, starting with fruit smoothies.

Literacy

Through rhymes, singing songs, games and techniques children are supported to develop their speaking and listening skills.

Children will be encouraged to practise developing their gross and fine motor skills which are key elements for mark making.

This term we will be again using props and visuals to retell stories. Looking at what some of our favourite stories are.

We will also be listening to and learning some words to Nick Cope – Plastic Bag.

Mathematics

Within Daycare we support the development of maths through fun and physical activities such as songs, actions and group games. We focus on the foundations of numbers 1,2,3; representing, subitising, recognising numerals and counting.

This term we will be using natural resources to count and compare.

Understanding of the World

Within Understanding of the World, we celebrate the children of our community while also making sense of the world around us. We celebrate what makes children unique and respect individual wishes and beliefs.

As a setting this is reflected in our celebrations, within the environment and books. This term we will celebrating daddies and father figures. Playing small but important roles in talking about and actioning ways to look after the world around us.

Expressive Arts and Design

Throughout our topic we will be supporting children to use their imagination in play and to get creative. We will use props to support understanding storytelling and singing. This term we will be creating father's Day cards and expressing creativity using mehndi in celebration of Eid.
