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### **Handwashing Policy**

#### Policy statement

Hand washing is very important for both the children and staff at Comper Nursery. Hand washing is the single most important measure for preventing the transmission of infection.

#### Aim

To support staff and children to know when to wash their hands and how to do it most effectively to reduce the spread of infection.

#### Procedures

- The staff wash their hands before handling food, after using the toilet, after changing a nappy and when coming in from the garden.
- □ The children wash their hands before snack and lunch.
- D The children will wash their hands after using the toilet.
- □ The children wash their hands when they come in from the garden.
- D The children wash their hands after messy play.
- I The staff will support the children, to ensure the children wash their hands thoroughly.

#### Technique

- Wet hands with water
- □ Apply enough soap to cover your hand
- Rub your hands together
- Use one hand to rub the back of the other hand and clean in between fingers. Do the same on the other hand
- B Rub the back of your fingers against your palm, do the same with the other hand
- B Rub your thumb using the other hand, do the same with the other thumb
- Rub the tips of your fingers on the palm of your hand. Do the same with the other hand
- Rinse your hands with water
