Dear Parents and Carers,

Tapestry - next week you will receive an email (if you haven't already) about how to set up an account and what information to expect on this platform.

Newsletter - a communication from me every two weeks with key messages about our school community. This will come on either a Friday or Monday.

Parents Evenings (face to face) —these happen several times a year and are an opportunity for you to discuss your child's development and wellbeing with their key worker or teacher. You will receive notice in advance of the dates.

Informal Catch up - drop off and pick are times when you can have a quick chat with an adult. Pick up is better as drop off is very busy and adults are trying to settle children.
